Information Technology Second Year Concentrations

FAQs

What is a concentration?

Each of the second year concentrations in Information Technology represents a distinct mix of courses designed to focus and prepare students for specific careers in IT. The available concentrations are Database Administration, Database Application Programming, Programming, Systems Management/Networking, and Web Programming. All concentrations have been developed through ongoing feedback from industry.

Am I guaranteed admission to my requested concentration?

Historically, most learners have been accepted into their first choice. Some students may be required to take their second campus choice if their first campus is oversubscribed.

When will I hear back whether I've been accepted to my requested concentration?

You will hear back typically by the end of March.

Do I need to select a concentration?

Yes, you are required to select a concentration for your second year or, alternatively, if you meet the admissions requirements, you may choose to transfer to the Computer Electronics Technician program. This option will require an application to NSCC Admissions. Please check with Student Services on your campus for further.

When do the concentrations begin?

Your concentration year will begin in September 2017.

Can I take any concentration at my current Campus?

Your preferred concentration may not be available at your current Campus. If it is not, you can choose a different concentration, or transfer to a campus where the concentration is offered.

Where can I get further details on my concentration options?
